LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends,

I am pleased to share with you our 2021 Annual Report. This report provides an overview of the year and helps us be accountable to you, our members, who invest in our mission, our people and our community.

Looking back on 2021, I am impressed with how our staff and board persevered in the face of numerous obstacles. Not only were we still in the depths of the pandemic, we also lost a key staff member in May and had to move our office unexpectedly. We were able to weather it all knowing that our work takes patience and perseverance. Successful land conservation requires not losing sight of the forest even when all you can see is a thicket.

Challenges aside, we still were able to focus on three major areas during 2021:

EAST MORaine COMMUNITY FOREST

Wallowa Land Trust spent more than 850 hours working with the East Moraine Community Forest Management Team on revisions to the management plan, on expanding the acreage of the Community Forest, and on improving access to this community treasure.

WALLOWA GATHERING RETREAT

Spring of 2021 was dominated by planning and hosting this seminal event, which brings native peoples to Wallowa County to gather traditional foods. Co-hosted by The Nature Conservancy, the gathering grew in size and complexity, with 75 tribal members attending.

ACCREDITATION

The Land Trust Accreditation Commission requires us to renew our accreditation every five years and we spent much of the year meeting their requirements – no small achievement! The Commission awards accreditation to land trusts that meet the highest national standards for excellence and conservation permanence. This meant Wallowa Land Trust had to undergo a rigorous review process to demonstrate our fiscal accountability, strong organizational leadership, sound transactions and lasting stewardship of the lands we conserve.

Our ability to continue this kind of work depends on your support.


CONSOLIDATED STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION*


